

Brief Description of Assignment Intending to accelerate the progress of the health, population, and nutrition (HPN) sector and address the challenges, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MOHFW), Government of Bangladesh (GOB) has been implementing the Health Population and Nutrition Sector Development Program (HPNSDP) for a period of five years from July 2011 to June 2016. After HPSP (1998-2003) and HNPSP (2003-2011), the HPNSDP is the third sector-wide program for improving health, population, and nutrition sub-sectors. The program's priority is to stimulate demand and improve access to and utilization of HPN services to reduce morbidity and mortality, reduce population growth rate, and improve nutritional status, especially of women and children. The duration of this program is from January 2017 – to June 2022 (1). The vision of this program is to see the people healthier, happier, and economically productive to make Bangladesh a middle-income country by 2021. The mission is to create conditions whereby the people of Bangladesh can reach and maintain the highest attainable level of health. This program aims to ensure that all citizens of Bangladesh enjoy health and well-being by expanding access to quality and equitable health care in a healthy environment. Proving research outcomes for the goals of learning, accountability, or demonstrating the worth of research efforts is becoming more popular. Assessing the impact of research on policy and practice, on the other hand, is challenging. The ways in which research is taken up, used, and reused in policy and practice settings means that linking research processes or outputs to wider changes is difficult, and timescales are hard to predict.
